

SLIP & FALL LAWSUITS

Slip and Fall Lawsuits: Time is of the Essence.

If you slip and fall on a municipal property like a sidewalk or a park in Ontario, you need to:

- 1 Take photographs of the area that caused you to fall;
- 2 Document the date, time and street where the accident occurred;
- 3 Contact the municipality and let them know:
 - a. Where you fell; and
 - b What was injured as a result of the accident.

The current law in Ontario requires that individuals who slip and fall on municipal property, like a sidewalk or a park, provide notice within **ten days of the incident**

If you are involved in a slip and fall accident on a private property such as a residence, a restaurant, or a store, it is crucial to document the area where you fell as soon as possible with pictures and videos. Otherwise, you risk the possibility that the person in charge of the property fixes the area where you hurt yourself and erases all evidence of negligence.
